

El objetivo del curso es introducir al estudiante a conocimientos básicos y de frontera en el área de Desarrollo Económico.

La evaluación consistirá de dos exámenes parciales, 20% el primero y 20% el segundo (último día de clases), tareas 20%, presentación 10% (ante penúltima semana de clases) y un trabajo final 30% (a entregar el día del examen final). Dado que se espera que al final del área de Desarrollo Económico el estudiante tenga una investigación terminada, es deseable que el trabajo sea de un tema en el que deseen seguir profundizando. El trabajo final se presentará y entregará el día del examen final.
